**Artyzen Grand Lapa Macau and Amagao Gallery
Present “Flowing Light • Radiant Colors” Exhibition**

***Renowned Macau Photographer Vong Sek Kuan
Redefines Photography Through Light, Movement and Consciousness***



[Macau, 6 August 2026] Artyzen Grand Lapa Macau and Amagao Gallery proudly present **FLOWING LIGHT • RADIANT COLORS**, a solo photography exhibition by acclaimed Macau artist **Vong Sek Kuan**, opening today at Amagao Gallery. Co-curated by **Ieong Man Pan** of 1844 Macau Photography Art Space and **Victor Marreiros** of Amagao Gallery the exhibition invites visitors to discover photography through an entirely new perspective, where light, movement and emotion converge to create images that transcend conventional photography.

Funded by the Cultural Development Fund of the Macao SAR Government, the exhibition showcases Vong's latest body of work, created using his original "camera-shaking" technique. Rather than recording a scene as a fixed moment in time, the artist deliberately moves the camera during exposure, transforming light and colour into expressive compositions that resemble paintings while remaining entirely photographic. Every image is created in-camera without digital manipulation, making each work a unique and unrepeatable record of a fleeting creative moment.

At the heart of the exhibition is the concept of **Landscapes of Consciousness**, where photography becomes an extension of perception rather than a reproduction of reality. Instead of documenting what the eye sees, the works reveal the artist's inner world, where memories, emotions and natural landscapes merge into vivid expressions of colour and movement. Through this approach, Vong invites viewers to slow down, look beyond the obvious and discover new ways of experiencing the familiar.

Mr. Rutger Verschuren, Area Vice President, Macau and Hengqin of Artyzen Hospitality Group and General Manager of Artyzen Grand Lapa Macau, expressed: "One of the pleasures of staying at Artyzen Grand Lapa Macau is discovering something unexpected beyond a traditional hotel experience. This exhibition encourages visitors to



pause, observe and look again. At first glance, the works appear abstract, but the longer you spend with them, the more layers of light, movement and emotion begin to unfold. Every visitor may discover something different, making each viewing a personal experience. Through our collaboration with Amagao Gallery, we hope our guests and the local community will continue to discover inspiring artistic journeys that enrich every visit to Macau."

Reflecting on his creative journey, **Artist Vong Sek Kuan** shared, "Artists must constantly challenge themselves through change. Every transformation begins with a change in thinking, followed by years of experimentation, practice and reflection. My hope has never been simply to photograph the world before me, but to express the world within me. These works represent the ongoing exploration of what I call 'imagery photography', where movement, light and emotion come together in a single moment. I am delighted to share this creative journey with everyone through this exhibition."

Co-curator leong Man Pan believes the exhibition offers a refreshing perspective on contemporary photography. "Photography has traditionally been associated with recording reality. Vong Sek Kuan asks a very different question: what if photography could also capture memory, emotion and consciousness? His distinctive technique transforms the camera from a recording device into an extension of the artist's body and mind. At a time when digital manipulation and artificial intelligence have become increasingly common, these works reaffirm the beauty and authenticity of creating something entirely in-camera, where hand, eye and heart work together as one."

An opening ceremony was held to mark the launch of the exhibition.
